Kenosha Track:

Tour of the Pike Creek Horticultural Center and Inspire Center

Pike Creek Horticultural Center houses the Greenhouse Operations and Landscaping programs. The Center tour will highlight industry-standard equipment in the center's greenhouses and state-of-the-art labs used for floral design.

The **Inspire Center** on Gateway's Kenosha Campus is home to Gateway's cutting-edge human patient simulation lab to inspire students in its allied health programs. Much of the first floor of the building is set up as a simulated health care or hospital setting, equipped with high fidelity human patient simulators, mannequins integrated with computer software which allows them to replicate patient responses to events and questions.

Racine Track:

Tour of the newly expanded SC Johnson IMET Center and O & H Bakery

Gateway's **SC Johnson iMET Center** hosts the region's first flexible manufacturing lab dedicated to training the manufacturing workforce, provides an innovative maker space at its nationally known Fab Lab, serves as the center for a number of Gateway academic programs and serves as a catalyst to help area businesses, economic groups and entrepreneurs.

O & H Bakery is a popular tourist attraction in Racine known for their kringle. Staff will provide a brief history of kringle, insight into the kringle making process and of course, samples of kringle!
